G.H. Mumm, La Cuvee R. Lalou, Champagne-France 1998

The ultimate insider Champagne made by G.H. Mumm from company owned vineyards. Aged for 10 years on the lees, it is rich and powerful with a balanced and long finish.



Clos Du Bois, Calcaire, Chardonnay, Russian River-California 2009

Classic California Chardonnay with intense aromas of apple, pear, lemon zest and tangerine and hints of vanilla, caramelized sugar and well-integrated oak spice.

Bright, vibrant flavors of pear, apple and citrus over a core of minerality are layered with touches of brown spice and nuances of cream.



Muga, Prado Enea, Rioja-Spain 2004

When I think of great red wine that deserves more attention, Rioja immediately jumps to mind. This wine has all the power of other classic reds but a silky texture and an animal quality that make it like no other!



Catena Malbec, Mendoza-Argentina 2009

Malbec is currently the darling of the wine world. If there is one wine that is the poster child for this obsession it is Catena Malbec. Grown in vineyards ranging from 3,000 to 5,000 feet elevation it possesses an explosion of complexity ranging from black current and plum flavor to a rich chocolate and pepper finish that goes on and on.
